Kerry Ellis has fast become recognised as a top leading lady of West End musicals from her starring roles in London and on Broadway. She has also achieved chart-topping success as a recording artist signed to Universal Decca with her debut album Anthems. She is absolute musical theatre royalty and we are so lucky to have her come in to speak to you!

Kerry originated the role of Meat, in Queen's We Will Rock You and was the first British Elphaba in the West End smash, Wicked, for which Kerry won the 2008 Whatsonstage.com Award for 'Best Takeover in a Role'. She then immediately transferred to Broadway and played Elphaba at the Gershwin Theater for 6 months, where she won the Broadway.com Audience Award for Favourite Female Breakthrough Performance, before returning to London for 6 months in 2009.

Her many other leading role credits include Grizabella in Cats (West End); Nancy in Oliver! (West End); Eliza Doolittle My Fair Lady (West End); Ellen in Miss Saigon (National Tour); and Fantine in Les Miserables (West End); Wonderland (National Tour); Reno Sweeney in Anything Goes (Barbican, London.)

Kerry's first major CD release was the amazing Wicked in Rock, a collaboration with long time friend and Queen guitarist, Brian May. This led to her being signed to Universal as a solo recording artist and her debut album Anthems was released in 2010 on Decca Records.

Ross is a technical singing teacher and Estill Master Trainer (EMT). He is Professor of Singing (Musical Theatre) at the Royal Academy of Music, London; and singing teacher at Mountview Academy of Theatre Arts, London; Trinity School, Croydon; Eton College, Windsor; King's College School, Wimbledon; and is the technical vocal coach to the men, boys and scholars of Chelmsford Cathedral Choir.

Previously, Ross was a Lecturer of Musical Theatre (Singing) at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, and was Director of Choral Music at Bromley High School for 7 years. He has taught at Bird College, Old Palace School, Blackheath High School and Forest School.

As a teacher, Ross was trained and mentored by Professor Anne-Marie Speed (Royal Academy of Music, London and The Voice Explained) and Professor Paul Farrington (Royal Opera House, Covent Garden and Paul Farrington Voiceworks).

Ross graduated from the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland (RCS) with a BMus (Hons) in Classical Vocal Studies, an endorsement in Community Music and a MA in Musical Theatre Performance. He was the recipient of a RCS Trust Scholarship and an Ian Fleming Musical Theatre Award. He has performed in concert and recordings for the National Theatre, English National Ballet, Abbey Road, BBC Television, BBC Radio, the BBC Proms, the John Wilson Orchestra, the BBC Concert Orchestra and the Maida Vale Singers.


