Rachel trained in musical theatre at the prestigious Mountview Academy of Theatre Arts and has worked extensively across theatre and television. Her theatre work includes Les Misérables (West End & O2 Arena), Billy Elliot (West End) and The Sound of Music (West End), among many others. Her screen credits include productions for the BBC and ITV, and she has also worked with the late Victoria Wood—an experience that spanned nearly a decade and remains a highlight of her career.

Rachel created **West End On Demand** to share her passion for the industry with aspiring performers from around the world. She believes that the skills developed through theatre — confidence, storytelling, teamwork and creativity — can transform lives both on and off the stage. Your week at West End Academy

Each week at the Academy offers an intensive timetable of professional training led by West End performers and top industry professionals. You will take classes in acting, singing and dance, alongside stage combat, audition technique and West End workshops based on hit London shows. Every week also includes a matinee excursion to a major West End production.

Weeks 1 & 2: Core Training

The first two weeks focus on intensive development across acting, singing and dance, with workshops inspired by top West End shows. Each week features fresh choreography, scenes and themes to build versatility and confidence across all disciplines.



The final week shifts focus from technique to performance and professional preparation.


You will work with a West End creative team to stage material from a musical, take part in a showcase session for an agent or casting director, and continue specialised West End workshops.

ACCOMMODATION 2026

For the 2026 Academy, West End On Demand is working with two trusted accommodation partners — **Prince Consort Village and Host King's Cross.**

We've worked with both providers at previous Academies, and they offer safe, well-managed student living in convenient London locations.

Rooms are modern, comfortable and purpose-built for students, with ensuite facilities and shared kitchens designed to provide independence and a friendly community atmosphere.

Students will be placed in one of the two residences depending on availability, our overall group size, and course length. Wherever you stay, you'll have everything you need for a secure and enjoyable experience while training in London.

The accommodation is arranged in clusters, with several private ensuite rooms sharing one kitchen and dining area. Wherever possible, we aim to house Academy students together in the same cluster, although this depends on overall numbers and availability.

You can sign up to our course for 1, 2 or 3 weeks. Check in/out occurs on Sundays each week, however for week 1 if you would like to arrive on Saturday 18th July this can be arranged for the extra per night cost. For any additional nights outside of this please request them with us and we will check if it is available. If you need to arrive earlier than 3pm please message us to check availability.

Location

- Both accommodation providers are based in central London (Zones 1 and 2), offering easy access to theatres, studios and transport links across the city.
- **Prince Consort Village** is located in Shepherd's Bush, a lively West London neighbourhood close to Westfield Shopping Centre and the vibrant music and arts scene in the area.
- **Host** is located in King's Cross, one of London's most dynamic and well-connected areas, surrounded by restaurants, cafés and cultural landmarks.

Prices: Summer 2026

- 1 week (7 nights) £485
- 2 weeks (14 nights) £960
- 3 weeks (21 nights) £1,420
- Extra nights charged at £65 per night

Prices include: Ensuite accommodation, Wi-Fi, linen pack, towel and use of on-site facilities.

Once you are allocated your provider we will send you an information pack with the details for the specific site. This will happen in May once we have everyone's applications in and we have a greater idea of our numbers.

Booking

- Accommodation must be booked through West End On Demand.
- The full accommodation balance is taken at the time of booking to guarantee your room. Accommodation payments are refundable until 1 May 2026 (less a 10% administration fee and any transaction or processing fees).
- After 1st May 2026, rooms will have been confirmed with our providers and payments will become non-refundable.
- By 1st June, you will receive confirmation of your allocated residence once all group numbers have been finalised. You will receive an accommodation brochure specific to your accommodation provider with all the final details you will need.
- We strongly recommend that all students take out comprehensive travel insurance to cover any unexpected changes, cancellations, or medical needs before or during their stay.

Accommodation FAQs & Practical Information

Will I have my own room?

Yes. All students have their own private, lockable ensuite bedroom, with a shower, toilet and sink.

Who will I share with?

Each residence is arranged in clusters, with several bedrooms sharing one kitchen and dining area. Wherever possible, we group Academy students together within the same cluster, although this depends on our overall numbers and availability.

Are there communal areas?

Yes. Both residences have shared social spaces where students can relax and meet others on the course.

Can I choose where I stay?

Students are placed in one of our two accommodation partners — Host King's Cross or Prince Consort Village — depending on availability, group size and course length. Both provide safe, comfortable student living in central London locations.

Is food included in the accommodation?

No, meals are not included. Each cluster has its own shared kitchen and dining area where you can prepare your own food. Both accommodation sites are close to supermarkets, cafés and restaurants, so it's easy to cook for yourself or eat out with friends.

What should I bring for my stay?

All bedding and a towel are included in your linen pack, and each kitchen is fully equipped with basic cooking items. The beds are small doubles, so if you prefer, you can bring your own sheets or duvet cover from home. We recommend bringing an extra towel or two, your own toiletries, and any home comforts to make your room feel personal. Please note that candles and incense are not permitted in the accommodation for safety reasons. A full list of suggested items and packing information will be included in your June course information pack.

Is there 24-hour support on site?

Yes. Both residences have reception and security teams on site 24 hours a day.

Is bedding included?

Yes. A linen pack is provided, including bed sheets and a towel. If you'd like fresh linen during your stay, additional packs are available for £17 each.

Can I do laundry?

Yes. Both residences have on-site laundry facilities.

How do I travel to the Academy each day?

Both accommodation sites are within easy reach of the West End by public transport. Students usually travel by bus or tube, and journeys typically take between **30 and 45 minutes**, depending on the route and time of day.

We recommend allowing **up to an hour** for travel each way to account for any delays or busy periods — this also gives plenty of time to arrive relaxed and ready for training.

You can pay for all public transport in London using **contactless card or mobile payment** (Apple Pay/Google Pay), or purchase a **weekly travel card** for unlimited travel in central London (around £42–£47 **per week**, Zones 1–2).

Are 16 and 17-year-olds allowed to stay in the accommodation?

Yes. Students aged 16 and 17 are welcome to join the Academy.

For safeguarding reasons, it is a contractual requirement of the accommodation provider that a group leader is housed on site when under-18s are present. This ensures appropriate supervision and support throughout their stay.

Any additional accommodation costs associated with the group leader will be emailed to you.
